MOTION SUBMITTED BY THE FFN

Modification to the election of Central Committee and Executive Committee board members

Argument

We propose the right to be re-elected once only for members of the Central Committee (meaning a maximum of 8 years in a post).

We propose a modification to the statutes so that the INF-FNI is more in line with many other non-profit institutions. By limiting the amount of time that a person can fill a role, it will rejuvenate the federation at least every 8 years, change its image and will bring in new ideas. This motion applies to the number of years spent in a single position, not to the number of years a person is in the Central Committee.

Current text:

§ 11: Central Committee

3. The mandate duration of the CC members is four years. Members may be re-elected.

Proposed text:

§ 11: Central Committee

3. The mandate of CC and EC members is four years, with the possibility of being re-elected once only. A member of the CC or of the EC cannot exceed a maximum of 8 years in a role.
