Report of the INF-FNI secretary for the 2020 World Congress in Slovenia
(Period 2018 - 2019)

Dear delegates of the World Congress 2020,

Before starting my report concerning the 2018-2019 exercise, I would like to thank all those who have placed their trust in my position as secretary by granting me a new mandate of 4 years with 130 votes for and 48 abstentions during the WC2018.

I would not like to come back to the abstentions of the delegates who didn't use their voting rights and did not want to decide clearly for or against, but this shows that there is a certain uneasiness within the INF-FNI, whether personal or other, which is really deplorable. Without wanting to go into detail on what happened during two EuNat events in 2019, this leaves a rather bitter and deplorable aftertaste going along with superfluous emails from both sides.

Where did the old-fashioned friendship that still reigned between 2010 and 2015 stay when I was still secretary of EuNat? Gone with the wind?

So, let's come to the facts!

Regarding our office in Hörsching in Austria and for which I am responsible, I can say that the collaboration is excellent, especially after the appointment of a lady who masters the 3 INF-FNI languages.

The collaboration within the EK is excellent because we all use the same language. That there are sometimes different opinions in the Central Committee is almost "normal" in a democracy, but we are always trying to come up with a common denominator in the interest of naturism.

Regarding my activity, I can tell you that the volume of email transactions was significant:

The organization of the 2018 World Congress had caused serious problems at the beginning since the organizer had changed during preparation, but could be resolved in collaboration with the FPN.

In 2019, we started to define the structures based on the new WORDPRESS software with our technicians for our new trilingual Internet page and the result seems to be very promising after going Online in early June 2020. A major problem still consists in the transition of the clubs from the old to the new page, since there are clubs that have not updated their data for many years and whose email address has changed or no longer exists. I therefore take this opportunity to invite the federations to contact their clubs so that they can do whatever is necessary, otherwise we would be obliged to permanently delete these "corpses".

The the new administrator task for updating the website (backend = utility for updates) has been fundamentally changed and does not make this task easier. Without a basic knowledge of the 3 INF-FNI languages, in my opinion, this can hardly be mastered. So, let's see what will happen after the WC2020.

Last wordings:

Everyone is well aware that it is very difficult to find volunteers to carry out these tasks, as evidenced by various vacancies within the CC for more than 6 months.

My mandate expires during the 2022 World Congress and I really wonder if I'm still willing to apply for another mandate, if the existing quarrels continue to scuttle our work by teams working in the background, but well known to us.
