MEETING OF EUNAT: 10-12 MARCH 2023 - BONN

MOTION SUBMITTED BY BRITISH NATURISM

Rules of the International Pétanque Tournament

This meeting notes that:

- the current ENC Sport and Finance Rules include, at section 4, “Competition rules for the INF-ENC pétanque tournament”, the following:

“The tournament shall be played by mixed doubles (2 players with 3 balls each).”

- However, in national tournaments organised by the federations, the doubles may be of any gender, and the current rules mean that teams other than “mixed doubles” are not eligible to compete in the international event.

EuNat invites the Secretariat, in consultation with the Sports officer,

to consider whether the current rules remain appropriate having in mind

- Sporting considerations
- Equality and diversity considerations, bearing in mind that according to section 2(5) of its Statutes, the INF “rejects all forms of discrimination”.

to report to the next meeting of EuNat with any proposal for change.

Argument

Concern was expressed during last year’s national pétanque tournament held in the United Kingdom. While gender is irrelevant to participation in the British Naturism doubles tournament, only those teams falling within the definition of “mixed doubles” are eligible in the international event due to the rules currently in place.

In the context of a naturist pétanque tournament where all the competitors are amateurs, it is not clear to us that removing stipulations around gender would confer any particular advantage over “mixed” teams. The need explicitly not to discriminate appears to us to be of greater importance.

This motion stops short of insisting on a change to the rules so as to allow time for the matter to be considered carefully before any proposals for change are made.

6. Request of the Serbian Federation for discussion

The Serbian Federation has submitted a motion for discussion at the EuNat meeting in Bonn. The text is attached to this document below.

With the request to discuss or set up a working group if needed.

Text of the Serbian Federation (italics):

The naturist organisation of Serbia, at the invitation of INF - FNI and EuNat, submits several initiatives for proposals related to changes in the statutes, organisational changes and changes that should lead to the popularisation of the organisation:

1) We propose that as a basic principle of the organisation, the status of the membership stamp be changed as follows:

a. The stamp issued by the INF - FNI should be a symbol of affiliation to the international naturist movement, so that a member of the organisation has a membership stamp issued by the INF - FNI and received by the national organisation of the country to which the person belongs.

b. If there is no national organisation in the country from which the person comes, and only in this case, it is possible for a person to become a member of the INF - FNI directly or of the national organisation of one of the neighbouring countries.

c. All benefits granted by individual organisations to their members should not be linked to the stamp but to membership of the national organisation. If a foreign national wishes to benefit from one of these advantages and is a member of his national organisation and has his own stamp, each national organisation should determine the conditions and the way in which the foreign national can benefit from these advantages and not have to rejoin the INF - FNI by buying an additional stamp in that other organisation because he is already a member through his organisation.

d. Respecting this principle, the meaning of belonging to the INF - FNI would be much more pronounced, the stamp would have a completely different meaning, because it would indicate that this person is a member of the world family of naturists and not just a means of earning money, by selling stamps in the name of membership. This is because the membership itself would be more valuable and valued, and the rights of members all over the world would be fully equal, which is the aim of the existence of the INF - FNI.

2) The Naturist Organisation of Serbia is of the opinion that it is absolutely inadmissible to allow membership of individual legal persons directly in the INF - FNI, unless this legal person is active in an area where there is no National Organisation. Legal persons of any kind are linked to the INF - FNI exclusively through their National Organisations, this also applies to individual naturist clubs that for some reason do not want to have anything to do with the National Organisation.

National Organisation. In exceptional cases, if there is no National Organisation in a certain area, it is possible to include a legal entity directly in the INF - FNI.

3) An individual who for any reason does not wish or is unable to obtain a membership stamp through their national organisation may obtain a membership stamp by joining through another organisation from another country or by joining the INF - FNI directly, but only with the written consent of the national organisation of the country from which the candidate comes. Only if there is no national organisation in the country of origin, no consent is required for membership.

This would avoid the possibility of admitting someone who is detrimental to naturism and whose right to membership has already been challenged in the National Organisations, or even a person who has already been excluded from membership.

With better control of the INF - FNI, it would gain both respectability and the trust of people who would be aware that they were joining a serious international organisation, and naturism could be spared the presence worldwide of those who harm this movement and damage its reputation, prestige and morbidity;

4) In the Naturist Organisation of Serbia, we believe that it is necessary for member countries to participate in programmes organised by an international organisation. We understand that financial possibilities are a limiting factor, so we should consider introducing the principle of solidarity, so that at all important activities, EuNat meetings, congresses, as well as traditional activities during the year, poorer countries and small associations are supported with additional discounts or subsidies, which would enable some representatives from these countries to appear as well. These funds do not have to be provided only from the INF - FNI budget, but can also be requested for free places from the service providers or to increase the price share for the participants who can provide the funds financially or by choosing cheaper forms of accommodation, e.g. hotels with a lower price. In the case that the national organisation is from a country whose members can participate financially but do not do so for unjustified reasons or do not show up for any event during the year, they should be asked to explain the reasons for non-participation and some kind of sanctions should be introduced for continuously boycotting INF-FNI activities (e.g. by withdrawing voting rights)
