We kindly ask participants who are interested in a sauna visit to bring their own sauna equipment, towels and bathrobe, if necessary. Towels and bathrobes can also be rented on site at the Wellness Centre.

As things stand today (January 2023), there are no individual corona rules.

The room rate at the Dorit Hotel including breakfast is 109.00 Euro per night for the single room and 129.00 Euro per night for the double room. Arrival from 15:00 on Friday 10 March 2023 and departure 12:00 on the day of departure.

The hotel offers superior rooms for an individual surcharge of 40.00 euros. Corresponding reservations are made via the hotel's registration forms.

Food and drinks (no alcoholic beverages) are provided. Own additional orders of any kind will not be taken over by the organiser/hotel.

The room rate is to be paid directly to the hotel. The reservation of the hotel rooms is made directly by the participants. The registration form is used by the EuNat organisers to plan the total number of participants.

Note about subsidies for events

At the congress in Luxembourg in October, the motion was adopted containing a new strategy to support the funding of naturist events organised by the affiliated Federations.

1. New strategy

Under the new strategy, funding is primarily intended to support the start-up of new naturist events. Events will be eligible for funding from 2023 if:

- They clearly promote naturism and participation in naturism, including by younger people
- The event could not be run without a grant (proof would be required)
- The event is open to international visitors (INF-FNI members)
- The event is open to non-members (e.g. guests of members, people experiencing naturism for the first time)
- Although a subsidy could be repeated in the following years, there should be a longer-term plan to allow the event to run without a subsidy, for example in 2-3 years.

The fact that a subsidy has been given in one year does not guarantee that it will be repeated.

In addition, if a Federation is awarded a subsidy, this should be made clear to all member Federations, for example in publicity material for the event.

Important note:

If, as a Federation, you want to apply for a subsidy during the EuNat meeting, it must comply with the above points.

2. Events organised by Federations on behalf of the INF.

Another point mentioned during this congress is that these criteria do not immediately apply to events organised by federations on behalf of the INF (swimming gala, pétanque tournament, family meeting, Alpe de Adria, Youth spring meeting).

However, these events should be organised in the same way as above and meet the above criteria.

During the EuNat meeting in Bonn, the EuNat Secretariat will make a proposal on how to meet the conditions and what choices have to be made in the not too distant future.
