## Important information

Federations are reminded that following the decision made by the World Congress and adopted by EuNat, applications for subsidies for events should be decided by reference to the following strategy.

- The overall strategy should be that funding is intended principally to aid the start-up of new Naturist events
- Events would be eligible for a subsidy if
  - They clearly promote Naturism and participation in Naturism, including by younger people
  - The event could not be run without a subsidy (evidence would be required)
  - The event is open to international visitors (INF-FNI members)
  - The event is open to non-members (e.g. members' guests, people experiencing Naturism for the first time)
- If a subsidy is granted, the fact should be made clear, for example on publicity material for the event
- These criteria would not apply immediately to events organised by federations on behalf of the INF (swimming gala, pétanque tournament), although in principle these events should conform over time.

**As was made clear during the meeting of EuNat in Bonn in March 2023, the expectation is that repeated events should become self-financing in time.**

To enable EuNat to make an informed decision on proposals for subsidies, such applications should be presented as motions, including the decision requested, argument and financial implications.

In particular, requests for a subsidy should include:

- Date and place of the event
- Explanation of the event
- Federation's own contribution and expected number of participants
- Requested subsidy in €
- Confirmation of and compliance with the existing regulations of EuNat
- Determining whether one-off or repetitive
- Rationale for the subsidy
